**HOW TO APPLY**

Applying is easy! Just follow the simple steps set out below. We are here to help, so if you have any questions, don't hesitate to contact the Blue Hills Admissions Office. We look forward to getting to know you!

This application form must be completed and submitted to the Blue Hills Admissions Office by the timeline guide specified below.

1. Please type or print carefully all information requested.
2. Please sign this application (Required by Parent/Guardian and Recommended by Student).
3. Print out and forward this application to your guidance counselor/school's designee who is responsible for preparing your application records. It may be your principal, guidance counselor or teacher (known as the school's designee). **In early fall, it is recommended that you submit your application to your guidance counselor/school's designee, so that your application will be completed timely.** Late applications will be considered, however, it may limit your opportunity for admission.
4. Your guidance counselor/school's designee is required to complete admission forms (Recommendation/Conduct Evaluation and Attendance Evaluation) and provide official copies of your report cards to the Director of Admissions and Financial Aid by the following timelines. *For September admission, it is due on or before the third Friday in December. For admission during the current school year, it is due on or before the first day of October.*
5. Once all information has been received by your guidance counselor or qualified designee, you are required to attend an interview appointment which will be scheduled at your school or at the Blue Hills Admissions Office. *If applying for September admission, interviews will be completed on or the last school day in January. If applying for admission during the current school year, interviews will be completed on or before the First Friday in November.*

Non-resident applicants will be considered only after all qualified in-district students have been enrolled. Blue Hills Regional Technical School has a published admission policy that is made available to all applicants and parent(s)/guardian(s) as part of the admission process. The policy gives the admission criteria, as well as a description of the entire admission process. It should be submitted by April 1<sup>st</sup> to the superintendent of your town of residence.
