**General Construction
Dental Assistant Program Space Renovation**

The Blue Hills Regional Technical School District, Canton, MA, is accepting bids from General Contractors for the Dental Assistant Program Space Renovation project at Blue Hills Technical School, 800 Randolph Street, Canton, MA 02021. The project consists of the renovation of 1,590 sq ft existing vacant space within the school building for a Dental Assistant program. This will include all new wall, floor and ceiling finishes, new dental furniture, fixtures and equipment, and new plumbing, mechanical and electrical systems. A Pre-bid conference and site inspection will take place on Thursday, January 15, 2026 at 9:00 AM at Blue Hills Technical School.

All bids must be submitted electronically through www.biddocs.com. Hard copy bids will not be accepted. General bids must be submitted by Tuesday, February 10, 2026 at 4:00 PM. Filed sub-bids must be submitted by Thursday, January 29, 2026 at 4:00 PM for the following trades: **Acoustical Tile, Resilient Floors, Painting, Plumbing, Heating Ventilating and Air Conditioning, and Electrical.**

Award is anticipated for the end of February 2026, with work to commence immediately thereafter and mobilization to begin on Monday, March 9, 2026. Bidders must have a DCAMM certification as General Building Construction. Filed Sub-Bidders must have DCAMM certification in their respective trade. Work is estimated to cost \$705,000.00 and bids are subject to MGL c. 149 §44A-J and to minimum wage rates as required by MGL c. 149 §§26 to 27H inclusive.
